The Basic Theater Camp is designed to introduce students ages 10-18 to all that is involved in putting on a live production. Participants will learn the casting/audition process; assemble a stage crew and learn the various crew jobs; work the stage through the use of cues, stage directions, and props; learn the acting process through voice projection exercises, staging practices, and play rehearsals; and finally stage an actual production. Those interested in discovering their artistic side are welcome to join our week of theatrics.
